Athletic Trainer

The Athletic Trainer is appointed at the discretion of the Athletic Director and Principal and is responsible to the Athletic Director and Administration for all decisions and actions.

Responsibilities:

- Is responsible for the prevention, evaluation, and rehabilitation of athletic injuries. The trainer will be responsible to evaluate and rehabilitate only those injuries that have occurred in a Saint Joseph Academy sanctioned event
- Is responsible for the purchasing, organization, maintenance and inventory of all training room supplies and equipment.
- Is responsible for the completion of Incident Reports for any student-athlete injured during practice or competition.
- Is responsible for the completion of reporting student-athlete injury to rankonesport.com and inform the Head Coach of their respective sport of the injury and rehabilitation plan
- Is responsible for the supervision of all student athletes who are transported for medical evaluation
- Exercises the highest degree of ethics and respects the bodily integrity of student athletes
- Is responsible for being present at all home athletic competitions and practices unless otherwise stipulated by the Athletic Director
- At times will be required to drive the school bus to athletic events
- Performs all other duties delegated by the Athletic Director or Administration
